ACCESS TO DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES

POLICY.

The laboratory and diagnostic services available to the Medical Unit for the adequate care of the inmates inside the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office – Adult Jail (AJ) are minimal. Therefore, those laboratory and diagnostic services deemed necessary and appropriate by the Facility Provider will be obtained from the community. In order to provide continuity of care to the inmates, laboratory and diagnostic resources are listed below.

PROCEDURES.

SECTION A: SERVICE PROVIDERS

- **A-1.** Laboratory and diagnostic services for the AJ are provided generally through the following sources:
 - a. On-site diagnostic tests available at the AJ are as follows: finger-stick blood glucose test, urine testing (dip), occult blood stool testing, rapid strep test, pregnancy test, peak flow, Influenza A&B, rapid HIV and Hepatitis C (in partnership with the health department)
