## TREATMENT PROTOCOL

## FEVER OR ELEVATED TEMPERATURE

- 1. <u>Symptoms/Presentation</u>:
  - Face flushed
  - Skin warm/hot to touch
  - Sweating
  - Inmate states he/she has fever
- 2. Take temperature.
- 3. If the inmate's temperature is 101 degrees or higher:
  - Take medical history
    - o How long has he/she felt feverish?
    - O Does he/she run a fever often?
    - o Are there any other symptoms? (aching, pain, nausea, etc.)
  - Contact Facility Nurse, Facility Provider or Emergency Room Physician for further instructions.
- 4. If the inmate's temperature is higher than normal (98.6 degrees) but less than 101 degrees:
  - Encourage fluid intake (water, juice, but no milk).
  - Give two Tylenol and/or Ibuprofen tablets.
  - Have inmate rest and recheck temperature in one hour.
  - After one hour, if temperature is the same as before or higher, contact Nurse or Medical Director for instructions.

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
